Our focus next week is the farm. Our class will talk about different farm animals and living on a farm!

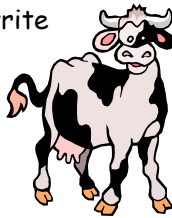
Math: The focus this week is still on patterns! The children will use patterns from last week as a review and use farm animal stickers this week to make their own patterns!
